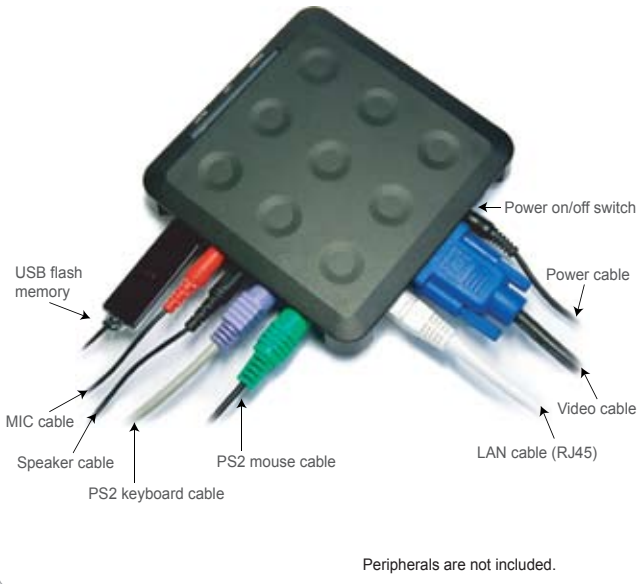

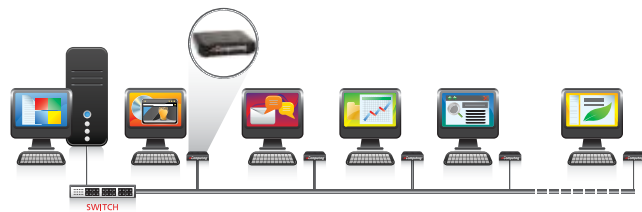

Get Dynamic IP Address

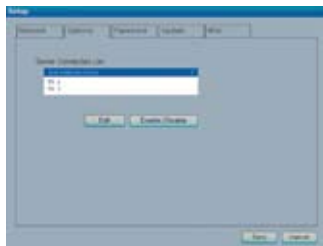


- 1 Select the "Network" tab
- 2 Select the "Dynamic IP address" radio button
- 3 Click the "Save" button

Use Static IP Address



- 1 Select the "Network" tab
- 2 Select the "Use Static IP Address" radio button
- 3 Enter the static IP address for the access device
- 4 Click the "Save" button



- Select the "Options" tab
- In the "Server Connection List," select "Autodetection" and click on the "Edit" button.



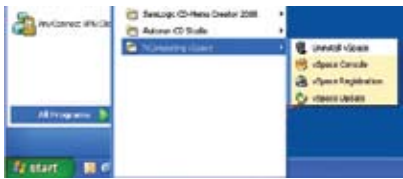
- Set the desired video resolution in the "Desktop Size" section.
- Click the "OK" button.
- Click the "Save" button in the "Setup" window

Step 4 vSpace Software Installation

Note : Connect the access devices and the host PC to the network when installing and registering the software. This assures the software will retrieve and register the serial numbers from each access device via the Ethernet connection.



- Run the installation program instructions.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.
- Add new users as necessary.



- After the reboot is complete, register the software and the access devices by launching "vSpace Registration" and following the instructions.
- If you are adding access devices to an existing installation, you must register each access device.
